Real LIVE Math

Believe it or not, strong fundamentals in mathematics are essential in about every career choice and are used daily. Students always wonder how they will ever use the math skills they learn in the classroom for "real life". This interactive STEM course, Real Live Math, will explore various career opportunities and experiences that campers may encounter in the real world that constantly use the mathematical skills they have learned throughout the year. We will begin with students demonstrating an understanding of basic algebraic and statistical operations such as solving simple expressions and equations, predicting the probability of future events, calculating area/perimeter of geometric shapes, and interpreting graphic information.
