

# HHS JROTC Requirements

The JROTC Program is a Leadership Course which teaches discipline in a classroom structure that develops courageous, character-driven young adults who possess the attributes of personal responsibility and accountability to become model citizens.

- There is an activity fee for each Cadet depending on their Leadership Education level, for a first year JROTC Cadet there is an \$85 activity fee.
- Cadets are required to wear the uniform on Wednesday or Thursday of each week unless otherwise determined by the Senior Marine Instructor
- No eccentricities in the manner of wearing head, facial, or body hair will be permitted. The hair color must complement the person's complexion tone. Females will wear their hair in a bun to which the cover must fit properly. Fingernails will not exceed 1 inch past the fingertip.
- Earrings or piercing will not be worn by males at any time while in the JROTC area or classroom and never in uniform. Females will not wear earrings or piercing of the nose while in the camouflage uniform, but may wear small, polished, yellow gold, ball, or round stud earring (post, screw-on, or clip), not to exceed 6 millimeters (about ¼ inch) in diameter must be worn with the service uniform.
- Males hair will be cut so as not to interfere with the proper wear of the uniform head gear. It will be evenly tapered, starting at zero length and no more than 3 inches on the top. The face will always be clean shaven.
